

USE AND DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

Alzheimer's Arkansas may use information you voluntarily provide on grant applications, volunteer or participant forms, and sponsorship or donation forms for the purpose of making a determination of eligibility, tracking, and reporting as may be required; communicating basic information about programs, services, or resources available; and for fund-raising activities. Information is not sold or shared with third parties.

If you do not want Alzheimer's Arkansas to contact you, notify Alzheimer's Arkansas and indicate that you do not wish to be contacted.

THE FOLLOWING IS A SUMMARY OF ADDITIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION MAY BE USED:

- When there are risks to public health
- In connection with judicial and administrative proceedings
- For law enforcement purposes
- To avert a serious threat to health or safety
- When legally required

YOUR RIGHTS WITH RESPECT TO YOUR INFORMATION

You may request restrictions on certain uses and disclosures of your information. You have the right to request that your protected information be provided by alternative means or at alternative locations.

You have a right to a separate paper copy of this notice at any time. You may also obtain a copy of the current version of Alzheimer's Arkansas' Privacy Policy upon request or on its website, www.alzark.org.

You have the right to express complaints to Alzheimer's Arkansas if you or your representative believe that your privacy rights have been violated. You will not be retaliated against in any way for filing a complaint.
